

SOME RECENT ADDITIONS TO THE LIST OF DIPTERA OF THE ISLE OF WIGHT

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In the volume 12 of the 'Proceedings' (1992), Telfer published a most useful provisional list of Diptera of the Isle of Wight. This article covered literature records from a variety of sources, together with data from specimens in the Saunt and Blair collections, and records from local dipterists. Telfer's total list for the Island ran to 437 species.

During the course of fieldwork over the last two seasons, I have amassed a large number of records of Diptera on the Island; a considerable number of these are species not included in Telfer's list, others are modern records for species which Telfer had no post 1970 records. Falk (1971) also cites some species not included in Telfer's list; I have included these records below.

In keeping with Telfer's list, the order and nomenclature of Kloet and Hincks (1976) has been followed, with the exception of the Syrphidae and the Tephritidae. For Syrphidae, the author has adopted the Stubbs and Falk (1983) checklist which is used by most British Dipterists. For Tephritidae, the nomenclature in White (1988) has been followed.

Brief locality data is given for species with restricted distribution; all records by the author relate to 1999 or 2000. Falk's literature records are marked with an 'F' and where possible data is given for these records.

A total of 91 species is listed below, of which 81 are additions to Telfer's list. The remaining ten are post 1970 records for species already recorded on the Island. One family, Acroceridae, is added to the list.
